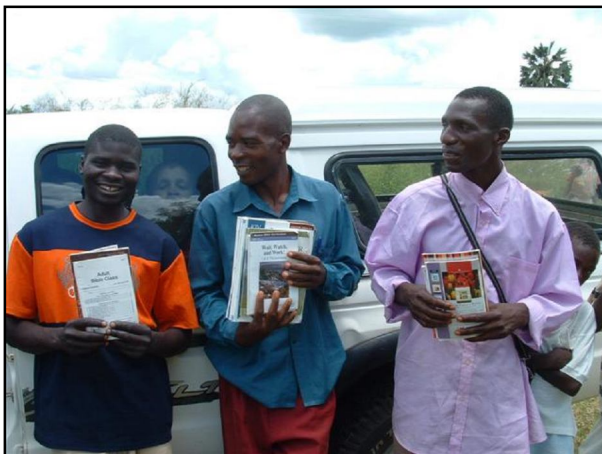


# LEFTOVER CHURCH LITERATURE IS NEEDED OVERSEAS

You don't have to throw away your leftover church literature! Bring it to Luke 19:10 Ministries. We will ship it to churches overseas that ask for it.

Christian churches overseas truly need our literature. 80% of all Christians outside the U. S. have no Christian literature at all. Most of them do not have the money to purchase literature. Christians in America hold 85% of all the wealth owned by all the Christians of the world. 20% of all the Christians outside the U. S. can read English. That means many can use our literature which is written in English. An example is the country of India. It has a population of 1,000,000,000. India used to be a British colony. Today 250,000,000 people in India can read English! Another example is the African country of Kenya. English has been taught in the public schools for the last 35 years! There are millions and millions of people overseas who can use our church literature.

Materials like these are very useful to us: Sunday School quarterlies, Discipleship Training magazines, Winter Bible Study course books, The Biblical Illustrator magazine, Open Windows, sheet music, hymn books, Jesus videos and CD's, video tapes of Christian music or Bible teaching, cassette tapes of Christian music or Bible teaching, CD's of Christian music or Bible teaching, Bible software, evangelistic and doctrinal tracts, Experiencing God workbooks, Radio Bible Class study booklets, etc.

We cannot accept sets of Encyclopedias. They would be appreciated overseas, but we use the funds that people give us only to ship specifically Christian materials.

## **What every church needs to do:**

- 1) Decide to do it. Vote on it, or just do it.
- 2) Find someone, or a married couple, to take this on as their missions project.
- 3) That person, or couple, can set up a system of collecting the literature and books in the church. Placing a box in the front and back of the church, and having the project announced monthly in the bulletin, is a possibility.
- 4) That person or couple, or other volunteers, must then sort the materials, putting all the children's S. S. literature in one group, all the adult S. S. quarterlies in another group, etc.
- 5) That person or couple should then transport the materials to Luke 19:10 Ministries. Our Ministry Center is located on the west side of Greenville S. C., one half block off of White Horse Road.
